❖ Foreign Direct Investment (FDI):

- Coventry and Warwickshire LEP recorded a total of 43 successful FDI projects in 2013/14, accounting for 3,146 new and safeguarded jobs.
- In terms of FDI success to date in 2014/15 (as at the end of November 2014), C&W remains
 one of the highest performing LEP areas in England in terms of numbers of investments and
 job creation through FDI
- Successes were derived from all regions, 19 from Europe, 14 from the Americas and 10 from Asia Pacific. In 2013-14 project successes spanned all the major sector clusters. Sectors that produced the highest numbers of projects were - Advanced Engineering and Manufacturing and Business, Professional and Financial Services.
